Hello Everyone!

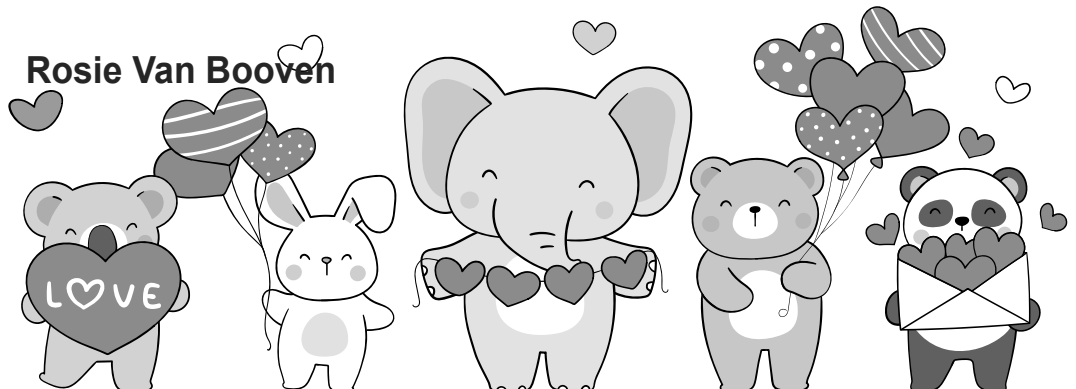

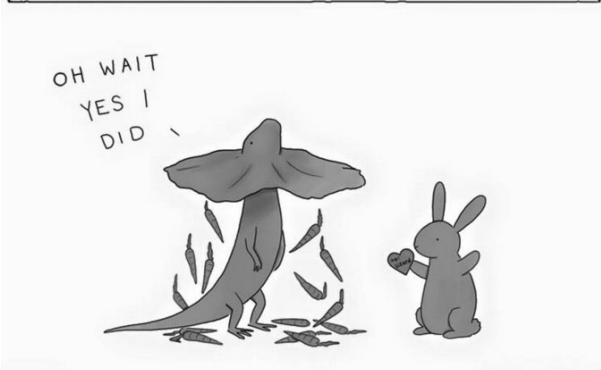

I wish I had listened to what my mother told me when I was young. What did she tell you? *I don't know, I did not listen!!*

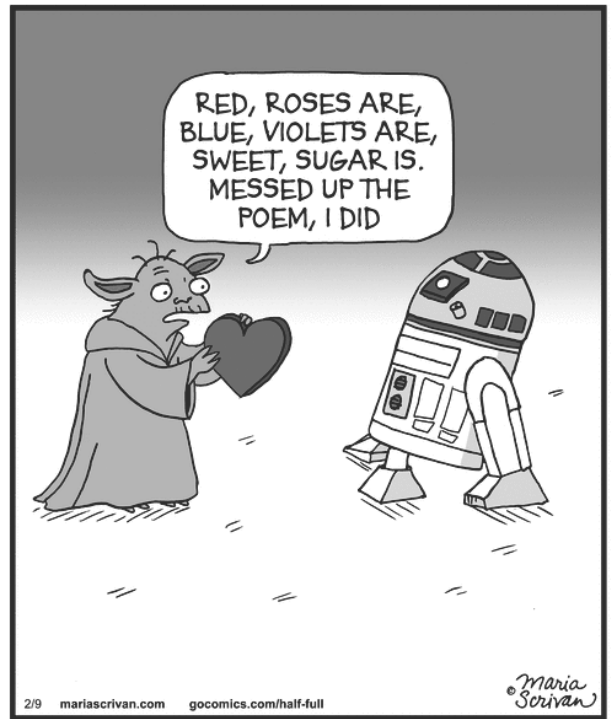
